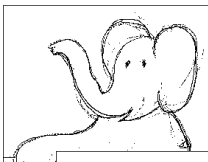

Reservations should be made by calling the church office at 858-459-3421 **by noon on Monday, June 15th**. Lunch, served by Girard Gourmet is only \$7.

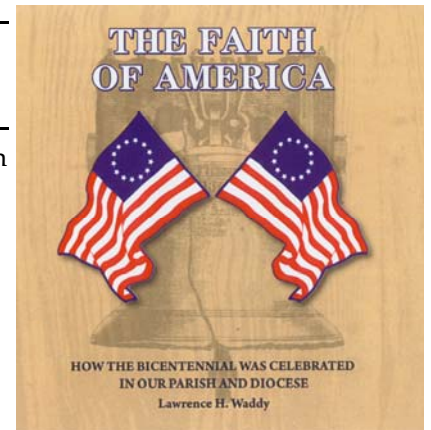
