10 am Sunday School – Children join their families today at The Bishop’s School.

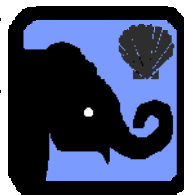
10 am Youth Sunday School – All Youth meet at The Bishop’s School for St. James Day Celebration.

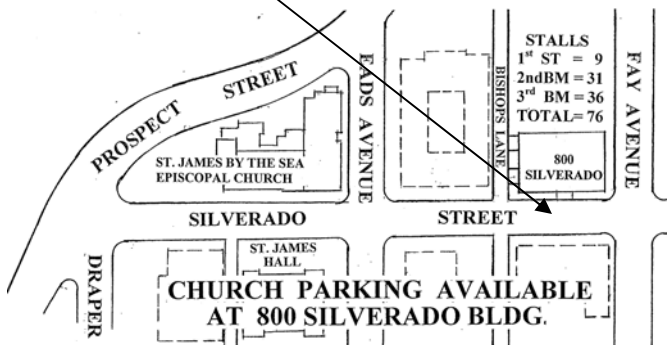
