CAN YOU VOLUNTEER LABOR DAY WEEKEND TO HELP THE ELEPHANT SALE?

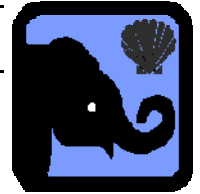
We need volunteers to help setup tables and racks for the sale during that weekend.
